DESCRIPTION

The Summer School in World History (=SSWH) is being held in the framework of the cooperation agreement between Nanjing and Trieste University. The University of Trieste joins with the **Department of Humanities (DISU)** and the **Department of Political and Social Sciences (DISPES)**.

The SSWH will be reserved to a group of **10 Italian students** of the DISU and DISPES, of the Master Degrees in “Historical Studies” (Trieste-Udine), in “Government Science and Public Policy” (Trieste) and in “Diplomacy and International Cooperation” (Gorizia). Students will take part in a mixed class with Chinese master students. The activities of the SSWH will consist of an approximate total of **27-30 class hours** plus guided visits. After presentation of a full written report on the activities carried out, the SSWH will earn the Italian students **6 credits of type F**. The candidatures will be submitted after publication of a **call** and selected on the basis of evaluation criteria defined by the persons responsible for each Department (Prof. Guido Abbattista and Prof. Diego Abenante). The call will be launched approximately at the beginning of March 2019 for a 10-days duration. Selections will be completed by the end of March 2019.

SSWH will be financed jointly by the Department of World History, University of Nanjing, by the two Departments of the University of Trieste, with the support of the Office of International Relations, University of Trieste. On the basis of an existing agreement, the University of Nanjing will provide students with full board accommodation in the Xianlin Campus from arrival to departure day. Students travel costs are to be borne by the University of Trieste, for a total sum of approximately € 8000, to be allocated pro rata between DISU and DISPES according to the number of selected students – tentatively no. 5 – for each department; the Italian teachers travel costs will be funded by University of Trieste, International Relation Office, under condition of a positive approval of this initiative. The requested DISU contribution for no. 5 students is expected to be of about € 4000, that is € 800 round trip Venice-Nanjing (plane ticket fares as of January 2019, to be verified at the time of purchase).
