



## **Avvio dell'attività integrativa extracurriculare dal titolo:**

### **“Conflict Management and Resolution in a Contested Global Order”**

Si comunica il prossimo avvio dell'attività integrativa dal titolo “Conflict Management and Resolution in a Contested Global Order” che avrà una durata di 20 ore e che verrà svolta dal dott. Giulio Levorato.

## **Obiettivi dell'attività**

In the last decade, the international security landscape has undergone significant changes. Many things that seemed inconceivable only decades ago have now materialized, like the return of interstate war in Europe. The continuing Russia-Ukraine conflict, the Israel-Hamas war, and instability in the Gulf and the wider Middle East, have made 2023 the year with the highest number of conflicts ever recorded since the end of WWII (UCDP). Within this context, the conflict management and resolution field has experienced significant upheavals. In particular, the rise of new powers, such as China, Russia, and Turkey, has led to competition among security suppliers and increased options for host states. Western interveners are increasingly unwelcome, and no new multidimensional peace mission has been deployed since 2014. The seminar presents an overview of the changes that took place in the field in recent years, from the progressive abandoning of traditional liberal approaches to the emergence of illiberal models of peace. Students will be provided with the tools to better understand the increased complexity of the conflict management and resolution landscape amidst a contested global order. Topics covered will be the crisis of the liberal peace architecture; stabilization and counterterrorism; conflict management approaches of rising powers; resistance, mimicry and adaptation between Western and non-Western actors. The coverage of the academic and political debate will be supported and substantiated by referring to relevant empirical cases from conflict and crisis scenarios

## **Programma**

Class 1 (2h) – The Rise and Fall of Liberal Peace (definition of the concept, historical development, watershed events, criticisms)

Class 2 (2h) – The Crisis of Liberal Peace and the Contestation of the Liberal International Order (factors, actors, dynamics)



Class 3 (2h) – The Marketization of Conflict Management and Resolution (causes, actors, consequences, empirical examples)

Class 4 (2h) – *Pax Rossica* and Chinese Developmental Peace (description and empirical examples of the Russian and Chinese models of peacebuilding)

Class 5 (2h) – Hybrid models of peace (Turkey, Gulf States, Brazil, India)

Class 6 (2h) – African Conflict Management (AU, RECs, Ad Hoc Coalitions, role of regional powers)

Class 7 (2h) – Conflict Management from Below (the role of civilians in countering armed violence, evidence from Colombia and Somalia)

Class 8 (3h) – Western Reaction to Illiberal Competition: Research Results 1 – UN/EU ‘Strategic Inertia’

Class 9 (3h) - Western Reaction to Illiberal Competition: Research Results 2 – European ‘Residual Counteraction’
